#PRES is the main conference dedicated to the renewable energy sector in Portugal and a classic hub for knowledge and networking for more than 10 years.


The main **public**, **governmental** and **private entities** gather in this event to debate the last updates in the sector, namely in what regards politics, regulation, strategy, and R&D.
